FAQ: How is support allocated?

Participant-specific support within a shared environment.

1. ALLOCATED SUPPORT



Team members are allocated to participants based on individual support needs, goals, communication profile, regulation needs, sensory needs, safety considerations, and the activity being delivered.

Support is planned, not random.



2. WHY ALLOCATION MATTERS

- ✓ co-regulation
- ✓ communication scaffolding
- ✓ transition support
- ✓ sensory adaptation
- ✓ emotional safety
- ✓ supported peer interaction

Support is active, not passive.



3. LEADERS IN REAL TIME

In many sessions, the number of leaders may be greater than the number of participants. This depends on participant support needs, the activity, and the risk profile of the session.
